April 18, 2024



The focus areas of this policy are:

#### 1. Green Audits:

To assess the college's contributions to a sustainable future, colleges can conduct green audits to determine the types and volumes of waste they produce. - Install rainwater harvesting system in the college.
- Install sanitary pad incinerators in girls' room.
- Install waste segregation systems in the college.
