Policy Document on Prevention and Prohibition of Anti-Ragging Committee

Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student. Indulging in a rowdy or indiscipline activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or Psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student. Asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or Psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Objectives:

The University Grants Commission has reiterated the ban on ragging of learners in Institutions of Higher Education. The learners admitted in the Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi, Gujarat are therefore directed to strictly desist from any kind of ragging in the college premises. The committee is tasked with the responsibility of furthering the ideals of the UGC Regulation and any other laws put in place with regards to the menace of ragging by the Governments of India and or the Gujarat State.

Ragging Constitutes:

- Any kind of misconduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes physical or psychological harm.
- Forcing a student to do any act against his/her willingness.
- Targeting a student on the ground of his color, race, religion, caste, gender, sexual orientation, linguistic identity or economic background.
- Deliberately creating a sense of shame or embarrassing a junior student or fresher.
- Force students to perform acts which can lead to physical injury/ mental torture or death.

Functions:

- To Prevent, Prohibit, and Redress any and all forms and instances of Ragging in the College.
- To educate the students on the meaning of ragging and what constitutes it.

- To educate the students on the ill-effects of ragging and the consequences, including legal consequences of indulging in ragging.
- To conduct awareness programs on the menace of ragging, its impact, consequences and redressal mechanism available.
- To enquire into any instances of ragging that have been reported, and if necessary, take all appropriate action against the students found to have indulged in ragging.
- Assist the Principal and other authorities of College if necessary, in notifying the appropriate authorities in cases of ragging.

Punishments:

- Cancellation of admission from the college.
- Suspension from attending lectures.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any Internal /semester end examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results of Internal /semester end examination of the college.
- Debarring from representing the college in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the college hostel.
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
- Expulsion from the college and consequent debarring from admission to any other college/institution.

Activities

- The Committee keeps a deep observation over any kind of act of ragging inside the campus (Classrooms, Canteen, and Ground etc.) and take prompt action.
- Anti-ragging banners are placed at various places of the campus to alert the students about this criminal offence.
- Frequent and surprise visits are done in the classes and private conversation are done with the new comers so that they can share any kind of embarrassing experiences that they may have faced.
- Emergency helpline number and email contact has been given so that any student can report any kind of ragging incident inside the campus.
- The Anti-ragging cell shows zero tolerance against any such reported act and strict measures are taken to curb the menace of Ragging.



In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, (Copy Attached at Annexure - I) to exercise the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website www.ugc.gov.in & www.antiragging.in.

It is brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed *Anti Ragging Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions - 2009* in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory, and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanisms. Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive actions as per UGC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging - 2009.

As per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court a District level Anti - Ragging Committee shall be constituted. The composition of the committee will be as under:

1. District Collector / Deputy Commissioner / District Magistrate - Head of Committee.
2. Head of the concerned University/College/Institutions - Member.
3. Superintendent of Police / SSP of the District - Member.
4. The Additional District Magistrate - Member Secretary.
5. Representative of the Local Media
6. Representative from District level Non-Government Organizations (Actively associated in youth development programs).
7. Representatives from student organizations.
8. Local Police, Local administration as well the Institutional Authorities to ensure vigil on incidents that may come within the definition of ragging.


This District level Committee should hold preparatory meetings during the summer vacation meetings to take stock of the state of preparedness of each institution and their compliance with the policies and directions or guidelines of the appropriate bodies, the university/State/ Central authorities; and this Court's guidelines in regard to curbing the menace of ragging.

You are also requested to organize publicity campaigns in this regard.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of Anti-Ragging committee and Anti-Ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officers' complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the institution's E-prospectus and E-information booklets/brochures must be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands must be carried out & Anti-Ragging posters must be displayed at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. These posters are available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. The size of the posters should be 8x6 feet. Any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled-for behavior/incident must be undertaken.

In compliance to the directions of the Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee constituted by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, HEIs/Councils have to implement the following:

1. The concept of mentor-mentee as given out in the UGC Regulations for curbing the Menace of Ragging in HEIs - 2009 be followed by students in all institutions to make a comfortable bond amongst Juniors and Seniors.
2. The Anti Ragging Cell and Anti Ragging Squads of institutions should be empowered by provisioning of a legal counsel so that airtight cases against the ragging culprits can be made.
3. Henceforth for extreme ragging and suicide cases, Principal of the college and Registrar of the University will be called and will be answerable to the National Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee for the reasons of non-compliance of UGC Regulations for ragging.
4. All the Councils/Regulatory Bodies must constitute a committee as and when a serious/suicide/death case is reported related to their Council/Regulatory Body to relook into the issue even when case is under police investigation. The Regulatory Bodies/Councils are also advised to appoint a legal person for the matter.
5. The Committee has also instructed the Anti Ragging Monitoring Agency to be more vigilant and carry out surprise checks all across the Nation to ensure that the UGC Regulations to curb the menace of ragging are being strictly adhered to by the HEI's, Teaching Staff and the students. Punitive action as mentioned in these regulations will be taken against the defaulters.

UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and has undertaken the following activities to promote the campaign which are available on UGC website www.ugc.gov.in

1. UGC developed 05 TV Commercials of 30 seconds each with different perspective for Parents, Victim and Offenders.
2. UGC designed and distributed 04 types of posters amongst Universities / Regulatory Authorities / Councils / IITs / NITs / other educational institutions for their prominent display.

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



2. Plan for Orientation Programme on Anti Ragging in your Universities/Institutions. The Programme should focus on key aspects of Anti Ragging Regulations and regular feedback of the students after each and every workshop/training/programme should be taken in English, Hindi and Local Language. UGC has made an IEC Kit with suitable content on ragging which is available on UGC website i.e. www.antiragging.in. This kit can be referred for the same.
3. The cultural dadagiri may be controlled by Head of the Universities/Institutions taking police authorities into confidence. In this regard, UGC is also issuing a separate advisory to all District Magistrate/SSP/SP of all districts.

4. The concept of mentor-mentee as given out in the UGC Regulation for Curbing the Menace of Ragging in HEIs - 2009 be followed by students in all institutions to make a comfortable bond amongst Juniors and Seniors.
5. The Anti Ragging Cell and Anti Ragging Squads of institutions should be empowered by provisioning of legal counsel so that airtight cases against the ragging culprits can be made.
6. Henceforth for extreme ragging and suicide cases, Principal of the college and Registrar of the University will be called and will be answerable to the National Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee for the reasons of non-compliance of UGC Regulations for ragging.
7. All the Councils/Regulatory Bodies must constitute a committee as and when a serious/suicide/death case is reported related to their Council/Regulatory Body to relook into the issue even when case is under police investigation. The Regulatory Bodies/Councils are also advised to appoint a legal person for the matter.
8. The examination (NEET/IIT JEE) causes high stress over students. There is no stress management mechanism available to cope with this. A team of good counsellors with expertise in yoga, meditation and psychology who can read stressful minds to tackle with such problematic cases need to be available. Therefore, a full time counsellor, Yoga/Meditation teacher/instructor may be appointed.
9. The Committee has also instructed the Anti Ragging Monitoring Agency to be more vigilant and carry out surprise checks all across the Nation to ensure that the UGC Regulations to curb the menace of ragging are being strictly adhered to by the HEI's, Teaching Staff and the students. Punitive action as mentioned in these regulations will be taken against the defaulters.


