⑪ Every professor should try to get his book publish so that we can take more points of this in NAAC.












Feedback and action taken report (A.Y.-2022-23)

Introduction

Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The college collects the feedback on various curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the students, alumni, Teachers' and Employers. The feedback collected from the individuals has been analyzed and taken to the consideration for the development of curriculum, teaching learning process and academic environment.

Students' Feedback

The Students' Feedback on curriculum and teaching learning process at Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi campus is designed to get formative feedback from students that can be used towards the improvements in the quality of course delivery as well as student learning experiences. Majority of the student population agreed that the syllabus is very much challenging and the teaching methodologies adopted in the classroom are praiseworthy. Majority of the students strongly agreed that the syllabus is covered by the teachers on time.

Feedback analysis report

- The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with the curriculum delivery and revision.
- The students highly appreciated the academic and infrastructural facilities.
- It is observed from the students' feedback that few of them expressed the need of more ICT facilities.

Action Taken

- More smart and experiential leaning and approach to competitive exams.
- More competitive exams guidance and career guidance lectures were conducted and a lot of reading material on these areas is included in library.
- Students are made aware of these facilities during Orientation Programs in the beginning.
- Teachers are asked to undertake more experiential teaching learning process.
- Teachers are also using PowerPoint presentations for enhancing teaching learning experience.
- Slow learners and advanced learners are given more attention according to their needs.
- Extension activities for social and environment sensitization are conducted.
- Placement and guidance cell has been strengthened.



Teachers' Feedback

Feedback on various aspects of curriculum is sought from all the faculty members of the college campus. The aspects such as provision of adequate time and resources for delivery of syllabus, coverage of both theoretical and practical components in the syllabus, the coherence of the syllabus with program outcomes, focus on necessary technical and teaching skills, ensuring components that inculcate ethical values, focus on flexible curriculum based on current trends, updated elective courses etc. The teachers play a pivotal role in delivery and implementing the curriculum, the inputs received from their feedback was taken into consideration for further necessary action wherever applicable.

Feedback analysis report

- Different types of courses related to skill enhancement have been conducted.
