- 2. Facilitate the exchange of undergraduate students. The academic standing of such students shall be determined by the host college. Exchange students will be accorded the rights and privileges of students in the host campus in accordance with the regulations of the host college relating to students and will be admitted under the terms and conditions relevant to the host college.

Accreditation for the academic work carried out by an undergraduate student during the period of study at the host college will be at the discretion of the student's home college.

- 3. Colleges will take some quality initiatives by IQACs.
- 4. Colleges may share some of the learning resources for the benefits of students.
- 5. The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both colleges.

- 6. The host institution agrees to assist in the seeking of appropriate housing, and to supply work space. library and technical facilities as appropriate.
- 7. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.

This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for <u>three</u> academic years' period from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked of modified by mutual written agreement between the parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement.

Either party may terminate the Agreement at any time during tile term by the provision of three months' written notice to the other party.
