B. Skill based workshops & Entrepreneurship

True Resin Art and craft, Palanpur to develop skills among students and create employment opportunities for them. To create an opportunity for exhibition of True Art and Craft, Palanpur and sale of their products by Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi.

C. Joint workshops and short-term courses

Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi and Tru Resin Art & Craft, Palanpur agree to participate in workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi and Truc Resin Art & Craft, Palanpur.

D. Intellectual Property

Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi and Truc Resin Art & Craft, Palanpur agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative activities under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

E. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for three years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi nor Trun Resin Art & Craft, Palanpur will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, Maniben M. P. Shah Mahila Arts College, Kadi and Tru Resin Art & Craft, Palanpur will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.
